

MEMORIALS OF BRO. R. E. CANNON.

To the Worshipful Master, Wardens and Bretheren of Rabun Gap Lodge No.
265 F. & A. M.

Death has again invaded our ranks on the 22nd, day in April in the
Year of Our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight .

It was the good pleasure of the Omniscient, Omnipresent and Om-
nipotent God to call from life unto death, from the walks of his brethere
and his fellowmen to that " Temple not made with hands" Our beloved and
lamented Brother, Russel E. Cannon.

In the death of Brother Cannon his country has lost a patriotic
citizen, his family a loving husband, companion and father and this Lodge
has lost a devoted consciencious member.

At the time of his death, Brother Cannon was 59 years 10 months
and 29 days old having been born in Rabun County, Ga. on the 23rd, day in
May, 1848. He was married in early life to Henrietta Bleckley who made
him a faithful loving companion and who with nine children survive him.

In 1870 Brother Cannon applied to this Lodge and received from and
in it the three Symbolic degrees in Masonry, having been a Master Mason
for more than 37 years.
