He was a native of Rabun County Ga. and was married to Laura L. Powell July 25 1893

He was an honest citizen, a true Brother and noted for his loyalty to his friends. He served as Sheriff of Rabun County for <sup>Six</sup> ~~eight~~ years and was popular with all who knew him.
